Review of Ethan Frome by Alyssa Ference

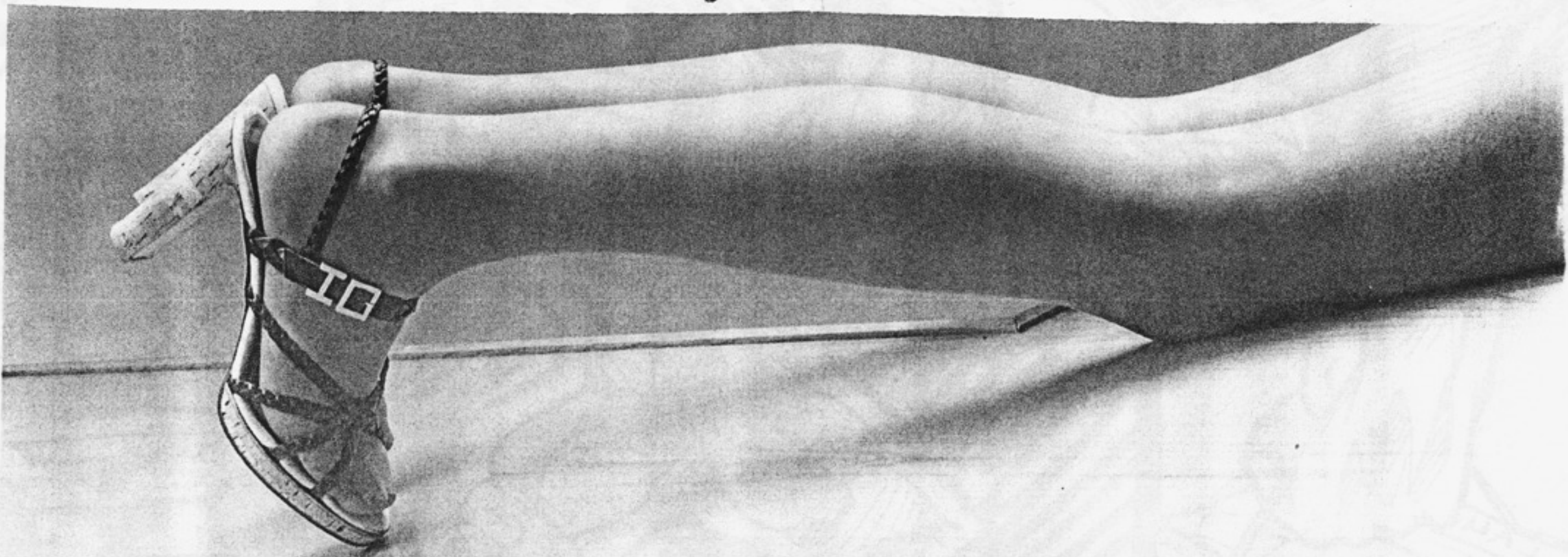
In not reading the book

I especially enjoyed the antics of Glenn Peckton, the jelly manufacturer. Him and Ethan got pretty creative with the toast and that Maggie chick.

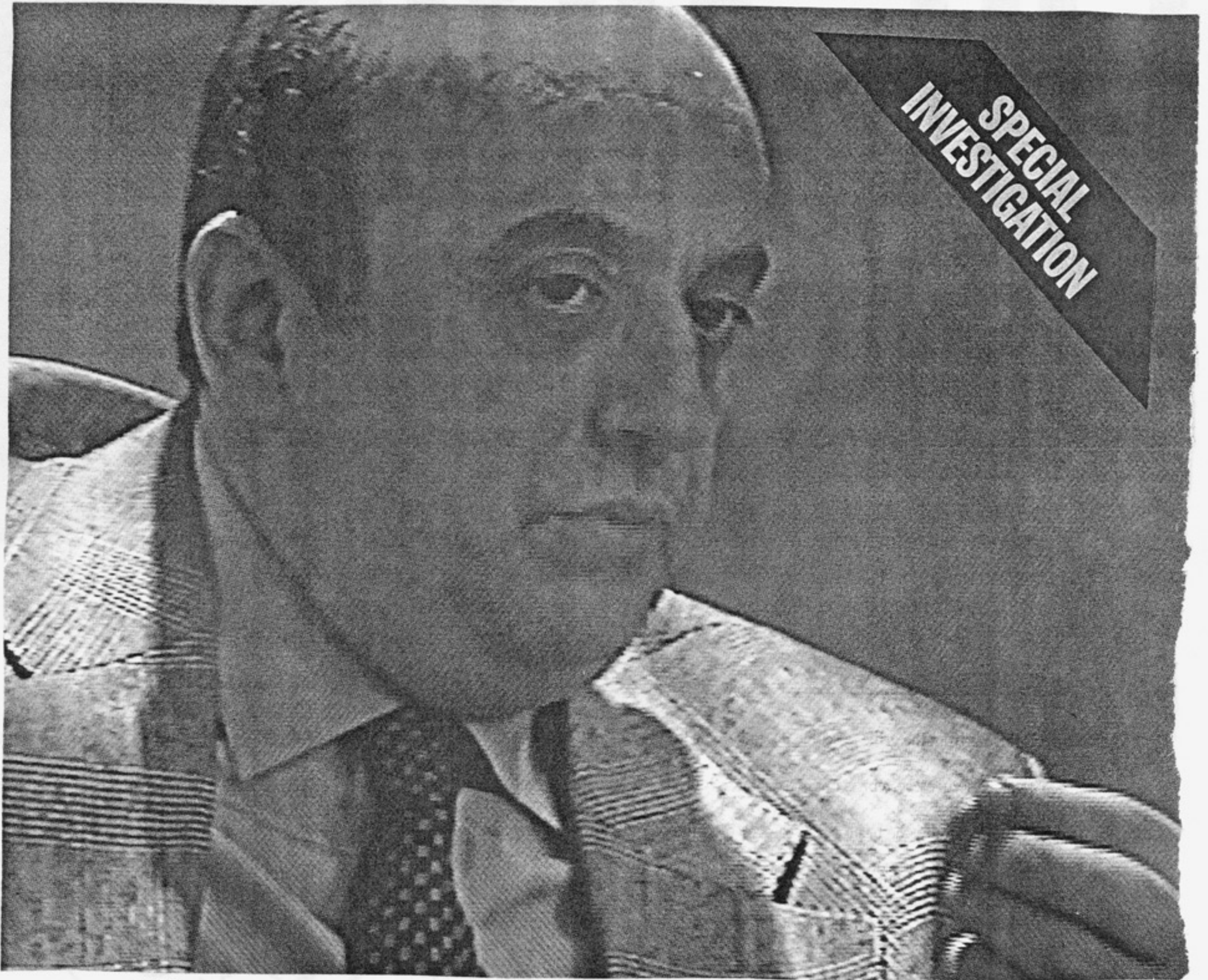
Besides commentating on the fallic symbolism of this book, I should mention that the use of allegory and hyperbole were very intriguing.

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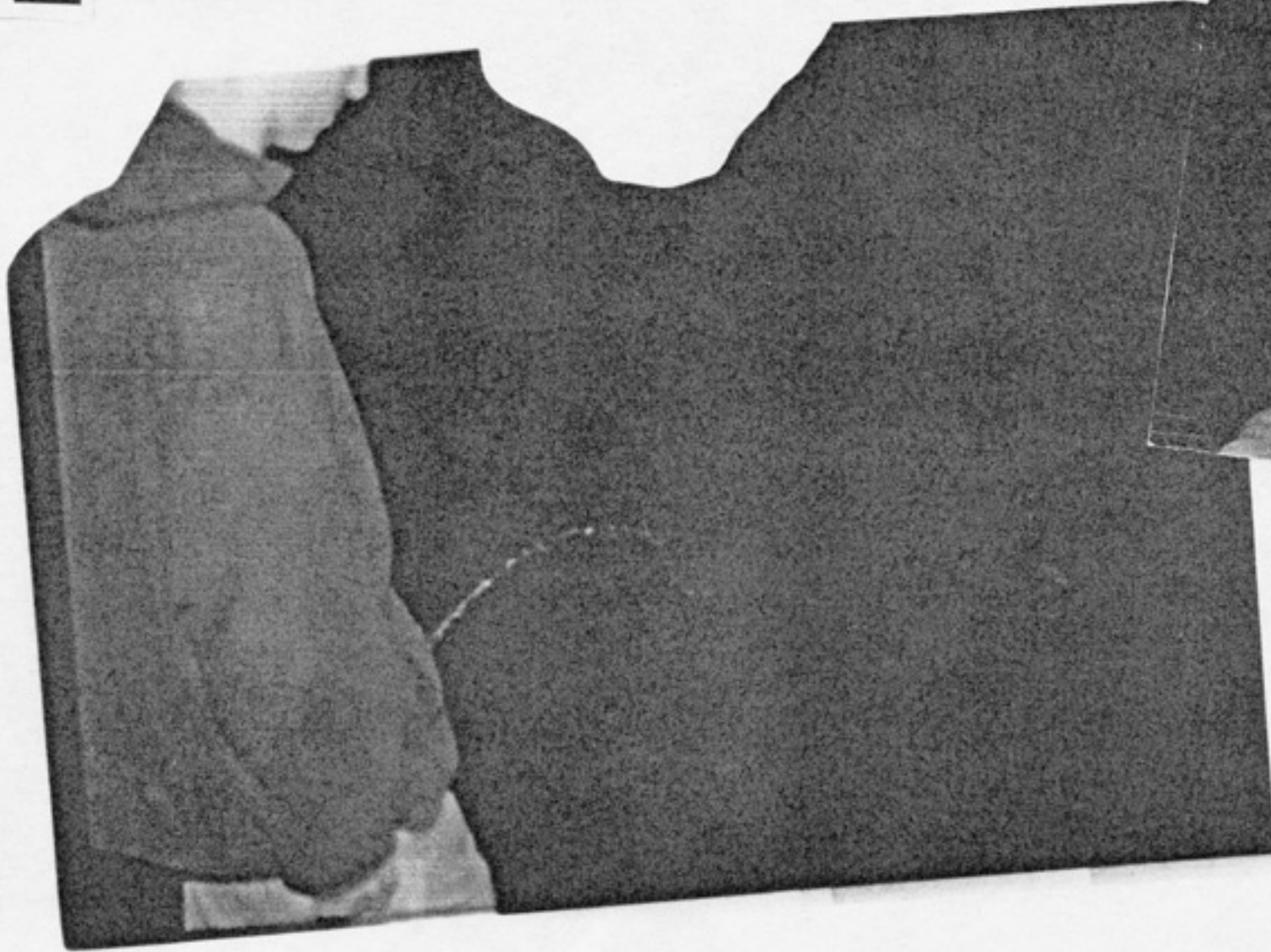
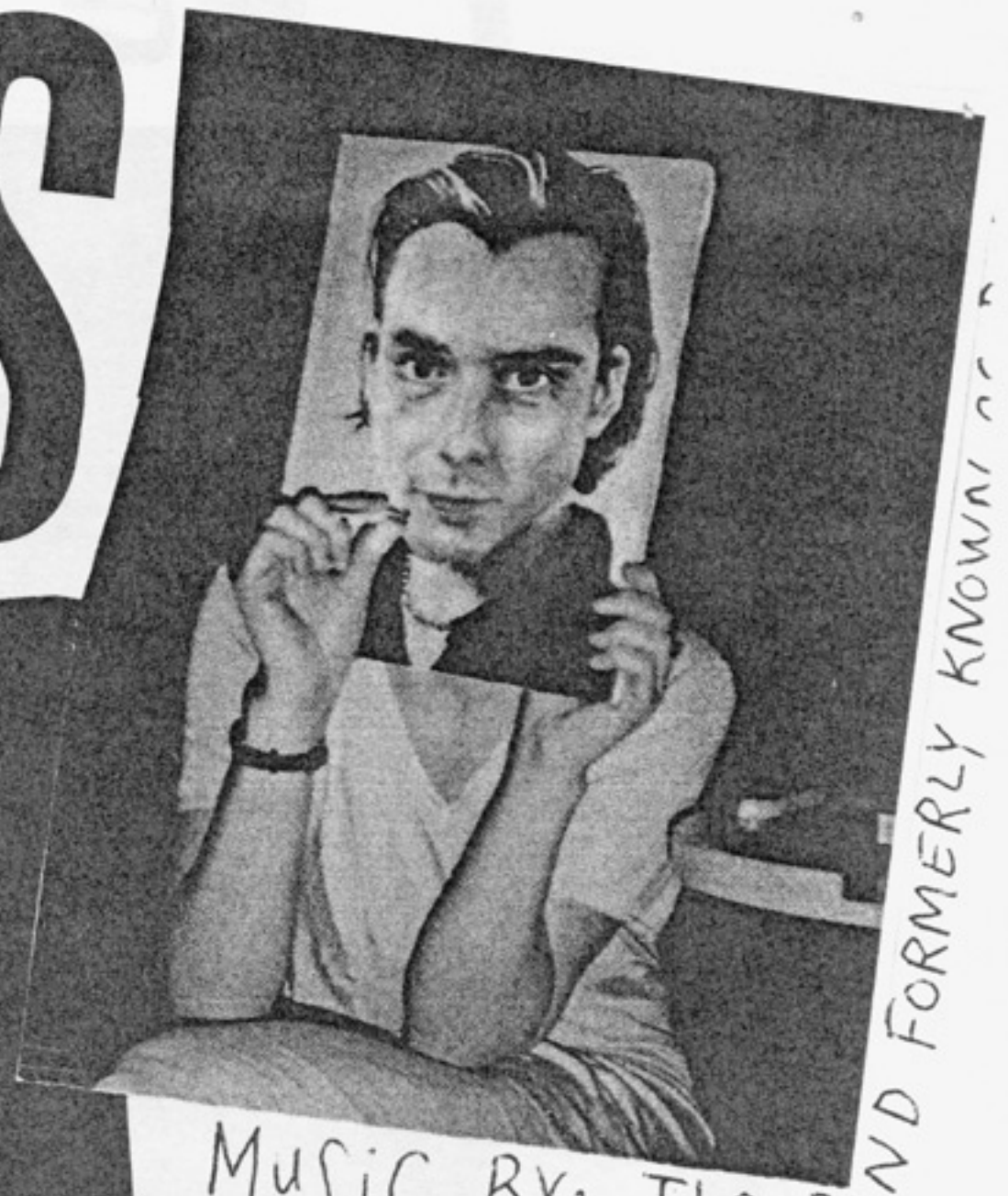

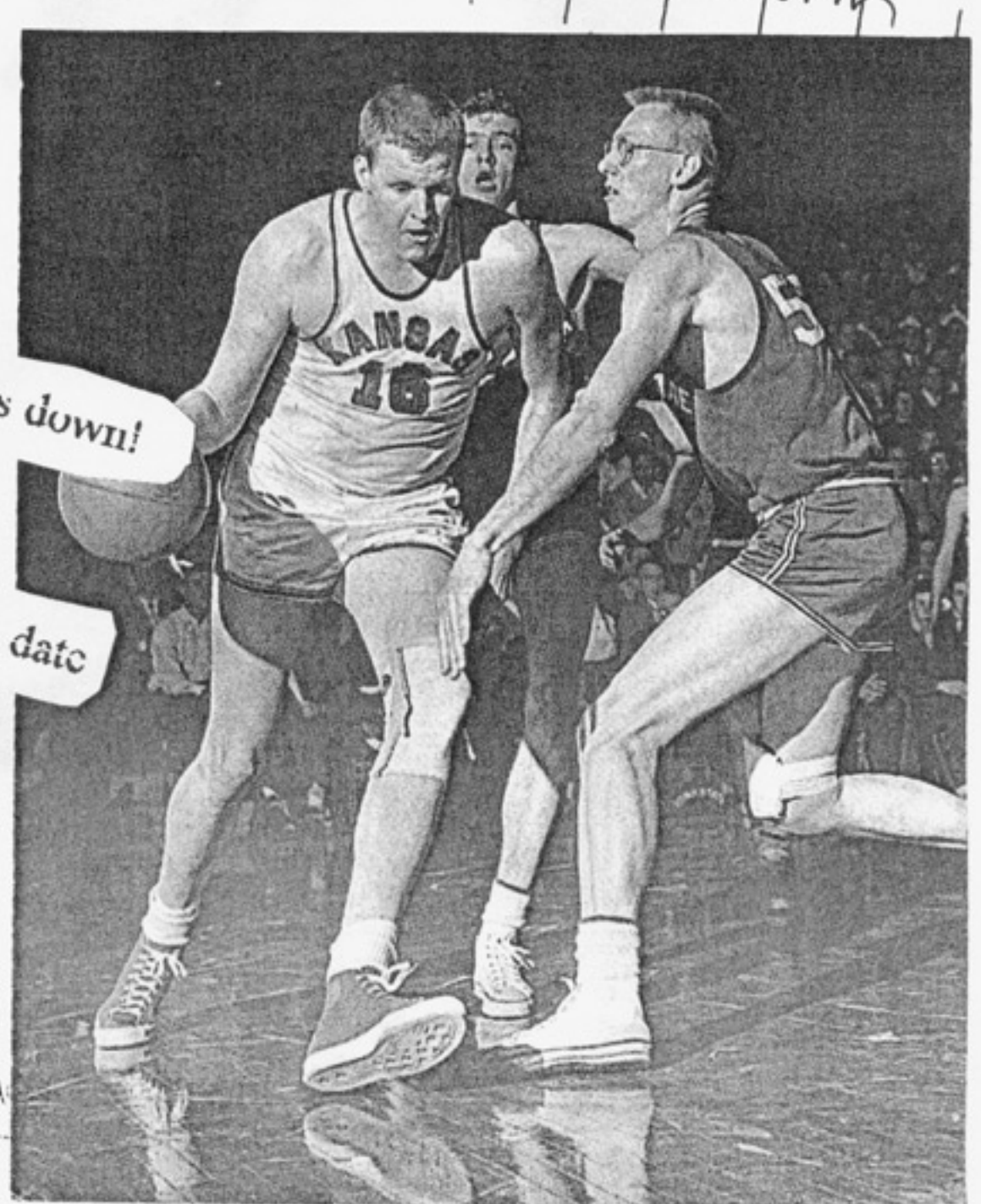


## T-ball Team Splatters to Victory

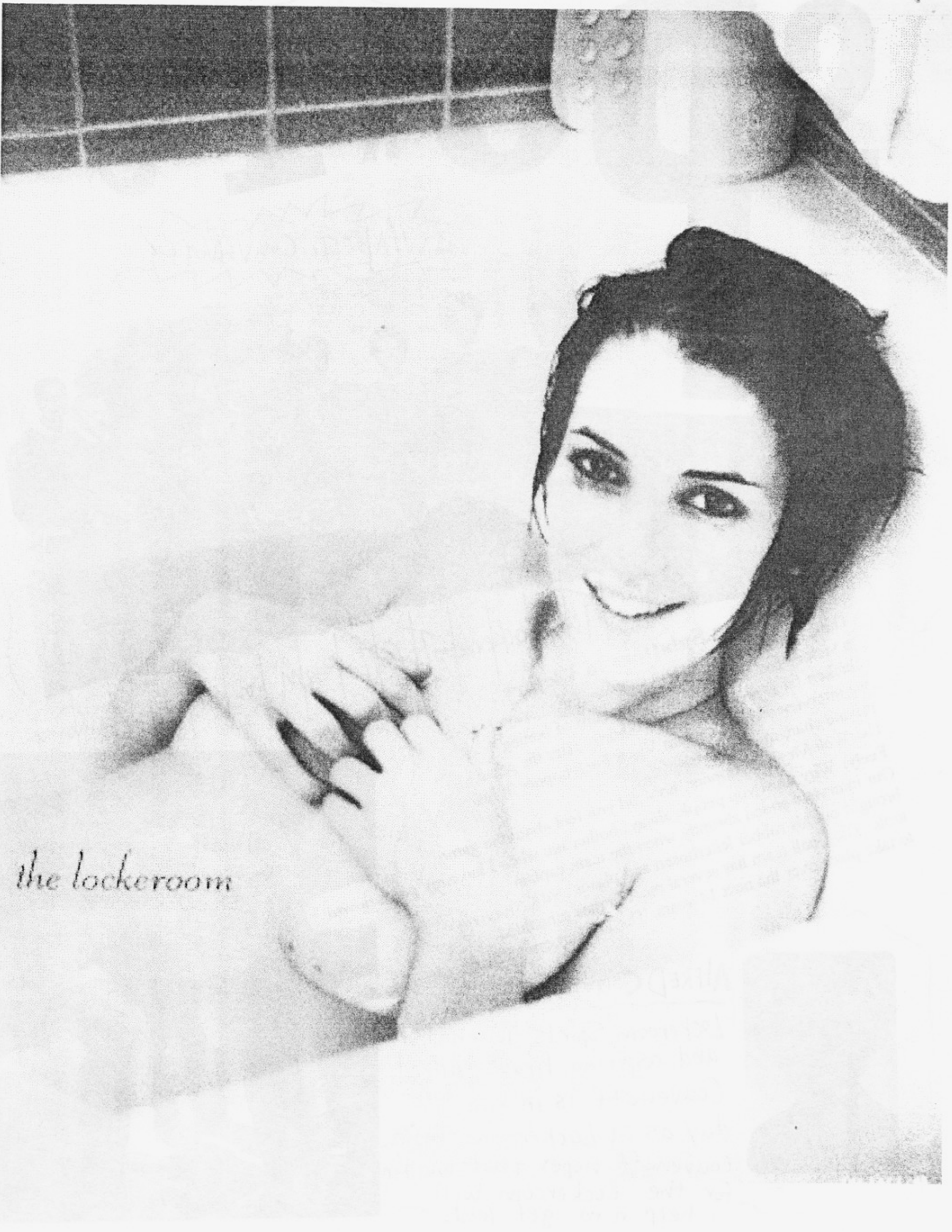
Us: Well Mr. Feelyhopner, how did you feel about the game.
